Tumble Books

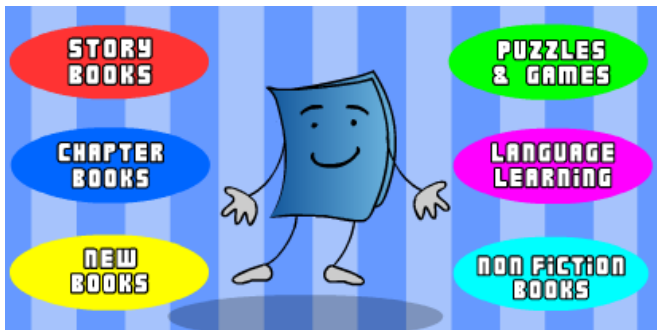
The TumbleBookLibrary is an online collection of animated, talking picture books which teach kids the joy of reading in a format they'll love. TumbleBooks are created by adding animation, sound, music, and narration to existing picture books in order to produce an electronic picture book which you can read, or have read to you.

The TumbleBookLibrary provides **enrichment to students who are reading independently** with a variety of high interest material. It also provides **support to students who require skill building** with a variety of exercises that can be matched with other areas of the curriculum. In general, TumbleBooks are a **great addition to a reading program** that can be worked on independently by each student or by the whole class. It has been exceptionally well received by ESOL and Special Education teachers.

Reading Options:




The Pause Button: You can use the pause button to stop the story at any time in order to practice story prediction, interpret pictures, discuss new vocabulary words, empathize with a character, discuss possible consequences of actions, encourage problem solving, or provide historical, geographical, or other perspectives.

Reading Options:

- Sound-click to turn sound off to read to yourself at your own speed
- Automatic-the pages turn by themselves and the book is read aloud if sound is on.
- Manual-you turn the pages and the book is read aloud if sound is on.

Click X to close at end of book



After Reading Choices



Each book has a multiple choice quiz that you can take right online after reading a book in order to test reading comprehension. The quiz tracks the number of right and wrong answers and produces a report at the end.



A collection of puzzles and games that reinforce concepts from the books, allowing for a fun and educational learning experience.



The lesson plans are designed to be both comprehensive and flexible in order to accommodate a broad range of reading abilities and student needs. Each lesson plan has an objective to help you choose which ones suit your needs best. Multiple lesson plans are available for some books.
